Lust: gr-epithumia (strong and intense desire for something evil (remember 2 Sam 13:1-2); it's used sparingly to apply to good desires. Primarily negative connotation, speaking towards sensual cravings, or coveting what belongs to another, and not to you).

Some things which lust provides, was never intended for you in the first place, but God will give it to you if you want it bad enough. (See Ecc 2:3-9)

Lust of flesh: Spirit of rebellion which lives _____ of you that fights right _____ from displaying itself (Rom 7:15,17; Gal 5:17, 19-21). The lust of the flesh is a desire contrary to God's will and fights against the things of God in a person's life. It can be food, alcohol, or anything which has the strength to take your eyes away from the Lord (Matt 5:28-29)

- This lust will infect a part of the body, but in time it will _____ if it doesn't get out!
- The lust of the flesh is subjective and affects folk differently based on indulgence.

Lust of eye: inability to see clearly because of what is _____ your view (2 Sam 11:2-4a; Gen 3:6; Matt 6:23). This lust _____ you from being able to clearly see anything else which should have been seen; and what the enemy is presenting 2 Tim 3:13, you'll be deceived and then go on deceiving others yourself.

The lust of the eyes is the quickest way to get into the brain stream, the eyes are delighted with treasures and extravagance. It is the lust of covetousness.

Pride of life: supremacy of arrogance over humility. No desire to be modest or meek; but seen and unsubmitive to whoever you are supposed to submit to. (Dan 4:20-22, 27-33)
